Biorisk Management is a comprehensive approach to assess, control, mitigate and ultimately manage risks associated with biological materials. Historically and from a laboratory perspective this has been done primarily under the umbrella of certain biosafety and biosecurity principles, practices, and guidelines. This sometimes very prescriptive approach is not sufficient anymore in today's environment. A much more comprehensive and performance-based management system approach is needed to deliver on the expectations for safe, secure, and ethical research, development, and diagnostic involving biological agents and systems. For that reason, the international community has successfully developed and published the first ISO quality management system standard for Biorisk Management, ISO 35001-2019.

The focus of this webinar is helping you getting the right start in a partial or complete implementation of ISO 35001-2019. Using specific clauses and requirements within 35001 as examples, we will discuss key implementation tools like:

- Document management, control, and organization
- Process flow and mapping
- Policy and objectives
- Metrics to monitor and track
- Quality processes like internal audit, management review, and communication

Part II builds upon the topics in the Part I webinar. It is preferred that participants have completed Part I to be successful in their participation of Part II.
