### 04. Fundamentals of Microbiology and Infectious Disease

**Fundamentals of Microbiology and Infectious Disease** is intended for those professionals who participate in protocol review, facilities planning, and any other risk assessment activities, but are unsure as to the actual nature of the disease risks of microbiological agents.
